Creating your own QR Code: Generating a QR Code is really quick and simple:

1. Open the internet and 'Google' or a similar search engine
2. Type in 'QR Code' generator
3. Select one of the sites,
4. Popular QR Code generators include: qrstuff.com, qrcode.kaywa.com and goqr.me.
5. Each site is self explanatory
6. Simply paste your email address, text message, website, You Tube or any URL into the generator.
7. The generator will create a unique code in seconds
8. Then simply copy the QR Code and it is ready to use

Scanning QR Codes:

1. You will need a smart phone.
2. Open the internet and download an QR Code reader, these are available free and are available for both iphone and Android formats.
3. Popular QR Code readers: Bee Tag, QR Droid, Neoreader and ScanLife.
4. Once you have downloaded the 'app' of your choice simply open it to begin QR Code scanning.
