Open access options for researchers

Journal articles

We have signed 'read and publish' deals with several major publishers. This allows EHU authors to publish gold open access (OA) with no article processing charges (APCs). In most cases, you can do so in the publisher's hybrid journals, but with Wiley it also extends to fully OA journals.




- The corresponding author **must** have a current affiliation with EHU. If publishing with a former student or with colleagues outside EHU ensure you are the corresponding author
- Use your staff or student email address when submitting, **not** a personal one
- If given the option, we recommend signing up for 'institutional open access' when you first submit
- Read through the terms linked to the above to ensure the journal you have chosen is included. If unsure, please contact Liam Bullingham in Learning Services


<p>Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ)</p>	
	<p>The DOAJ lists over 11,000 open access journals that do not charge any publication fees, allowing authors to publish openly without cost. 336 of these also meet the new 'DOAJ Seal' quality standard. You can browse the titles here and refine by discipline, language, Creative Commons licence, etc.</p>

Open Library of the Humanities	
	<p>Anyone can publish open access without charge with Open Library of the Humanities (OLH). OLH journals include <i>19: Interdisciplinary Studies in the Long Nineteenth Century</i>, <i>Studies in the Maternal</i> and <i>Le Foucauldien</i>.</p> <p>We are a paying member of the scheme, which supports this progressive, open publishing model.</p>

Books:

You can also publish whole books such as monographs on a fee-free, OA basis. We have joined [Open Book Publishers](#), an innovative, not-for-profit social enterprise which have produced over 150 titles - including works by Noam Chomsky and Amartya Sen.

OA publishers like UCL Press charge around £5000 to publish a book, but Open Book publishers do not necessarily need fees in order to publish your work.

Green Open Access

Unlike the above, most EHU research is published on a green open access basis. This typically means that the author manuscript can be openly published on Pure after an embargo period (usually 12-18 months). The publisher meanwhile, will offer your article to readers on a subscription basis or for a one-off fee.

Certain publishers like IEEE don't require an embargo, but others such as Elsevier and Taylor & Francis ask for at least 12 months in almost all cases.
